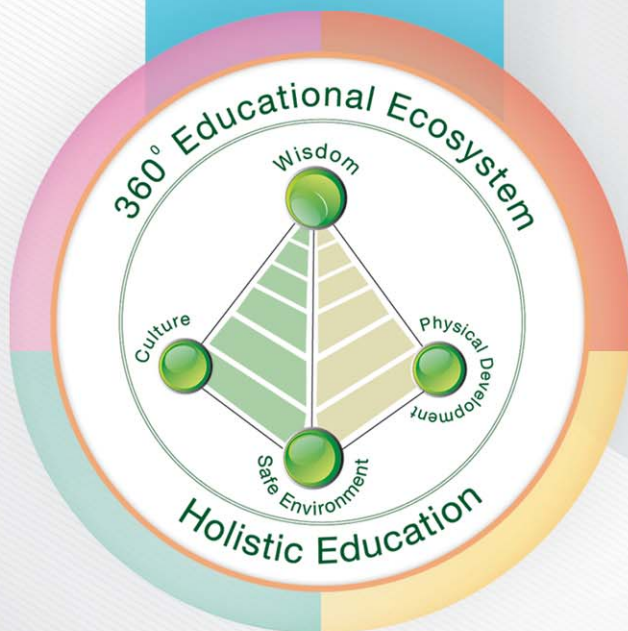
Wisdom

Computer Centre

Physics

LIBRARY

Library

Students are encouraged to cultivate good reading habits and use the library as an important centre for learning. Books and magazines from across the world adorn its shelves. Each child can choose its own corner and explore history, literature or science undisturbed. Personal supervision is extended to every child to improve his / her reading and speaking abilities. The students are motivated by small awards such as one for the 'voracious reader of the month'.

Communication Labs

French, English and Hindi are some of the languages that are taught with audio and dictaphone facilities in these language labs. This equips the child to build better interpersonal relationships and emerge a winner globally.

Herbarium

RMKRSSS has dedicated one-of-its-kind Herbarium to its students' community. Herbarium contains a collection of rare herbal plants which will help to understand the various types of herbal plants and knowledge on herbs gardening & maintaining it. Students actively participate in planting and maintaining the Herbarium at the campus.



Multimedia Theatre

"Seeing is believing". This multimedia theatre provides a perfect backdrop for the child to not only read the curriculum but also see it come alive in this multimedia theatre. This ensures that any ambiguity in the mind of the child is resolved.

Maths Lab

The 'MATH LAB' provides wide variety of materials to play with and learn the concepts. The purpose for teaching math through the use of hands-on activities is because math is a life-long skill that must be internalized rather than learned through just memorizing.



Engineering Graphics

Engineering Design is an elective (presently offered by a handful of institutions in Tamil Nadu) that provides kids with a rare opportunity to apply their knowledge of math and science while using their collaborative, creativity and problem solving skills to explore and create cutting-edge engineering ideas and design.



Swimming pool

The school has an all season international standard swimming pool for children to learn and experience the joy of swimming. Qualified coaches train the children in various styles of swimming. Exceptional students are identified and encouraged to take it up as a sport. Students have won medals in interschool swimming competitions.

All the play areas and fields bustle with fun and energy during the scheduled periods every day. Equipment and requirements for each and every game and activity has been met. Students are trained to improve and compete in a stress-free manner.

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Multi-cuisine Food Court

The school provides a hygienic multi-cuisine system with separate vegetarian and non-vegetarian food courts to provide healthy and nutritious food to the inmates. A well balanced dietary system is followed. There is provision for Jain food too.

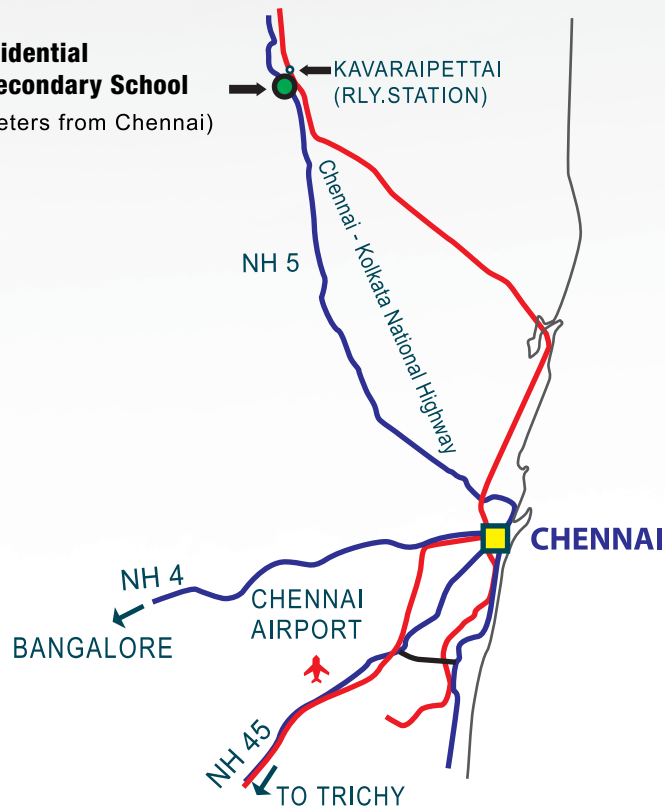
